





6th CSR Impact Awards 2019 - Winners

The CSR Impact Awards is an initiative of NGOBOX to encourage companies, CSR foundations and CSR implementing agencies to deliver high impacts through CSR projects and adopt a multi-stakeholder approach, leading to excellence in project outcomes. The 6th CSR Impact Awards, co-presented by Dalmia Bharat Limited recognized 25 exceptional projects in various categories of education, WASH, livelihood, etc out of an overwhelming response of 102 application forms from all over the country.
